

Trailer Rentals

- Reservations - Trailers are reserved on a monthly basis, i.e., on the first working day of the month, they may be reserved for the next month. (i.e. June reservations begin May 1.) All rental fees and security deposits must be paid at this time.
- If towing the unit outside of Idaho, you are required to have added insurance, check with your agent.
- Towing - it is the renter's responsibility to know their vehicle's towing capabilities.
- Trailers 18 feet and longer require a Class III receiver hitch.
- Tow vehicle requires: 2-inch trailer ball, two rear view mirrors (one on each side of the vehicle), and a 7-way electrical RV plug (temporary wiring will NOT be available). Some light adapters are available.
- Propane is the renter's responsibility, we provide the propane cylinder(s), but we do not fill them.

Camping Trailer General Information / Rental Policies

Although our camping trailers are equipped with water heaters, holding tanks, faucets, showers, electric wall plugs, lights, heaters, and some have air conditioning, you are camping, and everything runs on limited battery power, unless you are camping in an RV Park / campground with electrical hook ups. Battery power will provide power for lights and the heater on a limited basis, if you are conservative and do not run the lights and heater for long periods of time. The battery must last your entire stay, normal a battery will last 3 to 4 days, can last as long as 5-6 nights if you are conservative.

The air conditioning and wall outlets will only work if you are hooked up to an electrical source, as they won't operate on battery power. We do offer generators for rent if you need the power.

What do you need to bring? We suggest bringing; pillows, bath towels, and sleeping bags (or, sheets & blankets). Kitchen utensils, and pots, pans, dish towels, cutting board, a good knife, colander, Comet, ice chest, kitchen matches or a long barbecue lighter and a big pot with a lid for chili or spaghetti.

Camping Trailers are not a substitute for hotel, motel or condominium, but if you want to return to nature and experience the great outdoors, this may be the accommodation for you.

Rental Policies:

Reservations - Trailer are reserved on a monthly basis, i.e., on the first working day of the month they may be reserved for the following month. All rental fees and security deposits must be paid at this time.

Trailers are NOT available year round. They are usually available May 1st through September 30th.

Fees and Payment - All trailer rental fees to be paid at the time the reservation is made, plus a \$100 Security / Damage / Reservation deposit. The deposit is retained by Outdoor Recreation Supply as partial compensation for any additional cleaning, washing, missing items, damages, and any other charges related to the unit during the rental period. Your Security Deposit may not cover all charges and addition cost beyond the security deposit may be charged to you after your return. Your Security / Damage deposit will be available for return after the unit has been returned and checked in by an Outdoor Recreation Supply Staff member. Failure to completely empty the toilet (black water and grey water) holding tanks will also constitute a trailer not fully cleaned for which additional fees will be charged.

Cancellations Refund Policy - Cancellations must be made at least three days prior to pickup date to receive a partial refund of deposit. Cancellations made seven days prior to pickup date will receive all but \$25 of deposit back. Cancellations made six to three days prior to pickup date will receive all but \$45 of deposit back. Cancellations made within 72 hours of pickup date forfeits all of the deposit.

If towing unit outside of Idaho you are required to have added insurance, check with your insurance agent.

Towing - It is renter's responsibility to know their vehicle's towing capabilities. Trailers 18 feet and longer require a Class III receiver hitch. Tow vehicle requires; 2-inch trailer ball, two rear view mirrors, one on each side of the vehicle, a seven way electrical RV plug, (Temporary wiring will NOT be available) some light adapters are available. Max speed while towing is 60mph, excess speed may result in tire damage, takes longer to stop when towing.

Propane is the renter's responsibility, we provide the propane cylinder(s), but we do not fill them.

Familiarization Tour - approximately 30 minutes is required to acquaint you with the operation of the camping trailer before departure. This tour is conducted at the time you take possession of your trailer.

Repairs - If it is necessary to have repairs made during your trip, receipts and old parts must be returned to us for reimbursement. If a damaged tire is replaced during rental, keep the receipt and the damaged tire. Outdoor Recreation Supply is not responsible for tire replacement, changing flat tires.

Trailers - are not permitted on "logging roads", beaches or any non-public roads. Renter is responsible for any damage to trailer regardless of circumstances. Damage to trailer in any form will be paid upon return. You are responsible for the security and safety of trailer during rental this includes rock damage.

Driving Violations - Renter is responsible for paying all parking and driving violations. Renter is responsible for reporting all accidents.

NO SMOKING / NO FISH / NO PETS ALLOWED IN TRAILERS

Pick-Up - Your rental starts the day the unit is picked up. Camping trailer must be picked up, and towed out no later than 1630.

Early Returns - There will be no refunds on early returns. You have agreed and reserved the unit for a period of time. We have blocked that time for your convenience and you will not be given a prorated refund if you decide to turn in the unit earlier than reserved.

Returning Camper - Return unit clean. CLEAN MEANS CLEAN ENOUGH TO SEND BACK OUT TO RENT. Unit needs to be cleaned out of all personal property, swept, counters washed and any spills in the refrigerator need to be washed out. Cleaning fees will be charged if the unit is not returned clean on interior and exterior. This includes rinsing of the holding tanks with water and leaving the dump valves, and caps open when you return the unit so there will be no question of the unit being dumped sufficiently. Keys, electrical connections, water hoses, retainer clips etc. will be charged the full replacement cost. Interior cleaning fee is \$40 min. Exterior cleaning fee is \$20 min. Emptying holding tanks \$60 min. fee. Additional cleaning fees may be charged at \$25 per hour.

Return trailer by 1000 to avoid paying for an additional day(s).

Please call us letting us know if you are going to be late; your trailer may be booked for another customer. Returning a trailer in later than the date you have agreed on by contract is not an option, unless you call and receive approval from Outdoor Recreation. (208) 828-6333
