MEMORANDUM FOR ALL MOUNTAIN HOME AFB DINING FACILITY CUSTOMERS

SUBJECT: Authorized Dining Facility Patrons

1. In accordance with AFMAN 34-240, *Appropriated Fund (APF) Food Service Program Management*, Attachment 2, the installation commander may authorize other guests to eat in the facility when it is determined to be in the best interest of the Air Force and does not affect the essential station messing customers. The decision on authorized dining facility patrons was delegated to the Force Support Squadron Commander by the Mountain Home AFB's 366th Fighter Wing Commander.

2. The following personnel are authorized to utilize the Wagon Wheel Dining Facility at no surcharge rate:

a. Enlisted members who are in essential station messing program (while not on leave or per diem order).

b. Members of nonprofit youth groups invited to visit Mountain Home Air Force Base (e.g., Civil Air Patrol, Junior ROTC, and Scouting units).

c. Spouses and other dependents of enlisted personnel in pay grades E-1 through E-4.

d. Officers, enlisted members, federal employees on Joint Task Force operations other than training.

e. Officers, enlisted members, and federal employees who are not receiving the meal portion of per diem, and who are on a U.S. Government aircraft on official duty either as a passenger or as a crew member engaged in flight operations.

3. The following personnel are authorized to utilize the Wagon Wheel Dining Facility at surcharge rate:

a. Enlisted members who receive BAS.

b. Foreign government enlisted military personnel.

c. DoD personnel receiving the meal portion of per diem, as indicated on TDY orders.

- d. Commanders and flight commanders, for quality of life and customer service evaluations.
  - e. Officers and DoD Civilians in first responder roles, (e.g., Fire Department, Medical, Security Forces- excluding gate guards) and members of the Emergency Snow Removal Team.
  - f. On-duty officers.
  - g. Military retirees who are employees of Mountain Home AFB or registered guests of the Sagebrush Inn. All other retired military personnel are authorized during weekends.
  - h. Dependents of deployed members participating in sponsored programs (e.g., Hearts Apart).
  - i. All personnel with access to the installation on Thanksgiving and Christmas Day.
